



Free Surgery & Medical Camp for the Disabled in Hyderabad

Description

Hyderabad: Under the auspices of the Indian Red Cross Society, Hyderabad Branch, a grand Free Mega Surgery & Medical Camp was organized at Samskruti Raj Bhavan Community Hall, Somajiguda with the support of Disable Trust, Badri Vishal Pannalal Pitti Trust, Agarwal Sevalal, Mahaveer Viklang Sahayata Samiti, Dr. Nari Charitable Trust, Ramdev Rao Hospital, and Janajagruti Trust.

Honorable Telangana Governor Shri Jishnu Dev Varma graced the event as the Chief Guest and distributed electric vehicles, crutches, calipers, artificial limbs, walkers, and wheelchairs to the beneficiaries.

Special Guests included State Minister Shri Adluri Laxman and Hyderabad Collector Smt. Harichandana.

The program was attended by Disable Trust Chairman Veeraiah, Red Cross State CEO Sriramulu, MLA Kala Yadayya, Red Cross Chairman Bheem Reddy, and Dr. Vijay Bhaskar (Organizing Chairman).

Minister Adluri Laxman assured that adequate funds and support would be provided for the welfare and development of persons with disabilities.

Organizing Chairman Dr. Vijay Bhaskar highlighted the significance of microsurgeries in correcting physical deformities.
