In view of the rising tensions in West Asia, the Government of India has released emergency helpline numbers to ensure the safety of nearly 9.6 million Indians residing in the region. Indians facing emergencies such as medical assistance, security concerns, or evacuation needs are advised to contact the respective Indian Missions in their country of residence.
